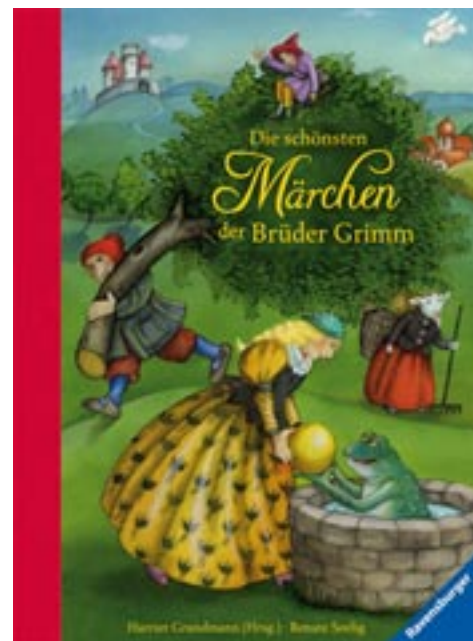
The following fairy tales are included in this volume:
