CONTENT

In late summer 1484, a mysterious guest stays with Ravensburg merchant Humpis and immediately starts flirting with the beautiful maid Magdalene. THE AUTHOR

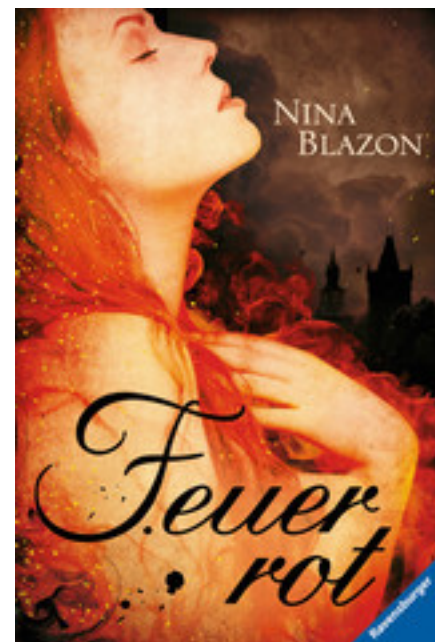

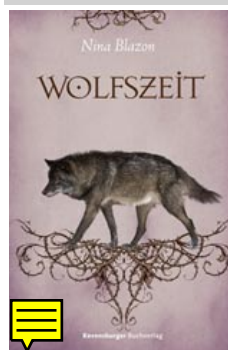
