### ABOUT THE SERIES

### CONTENT

Viggo is sold to the Viking king as a scribe, and when the royal court is attacked by a mythical creature, it becomes clear to everyone that Ragnarök is unfolding.

There are rumors of a new world, however – the world Viggo knows as America. King Olaf sends none other than Leif Eriksson to find that world, and Viggo is appointed his chronicler. Their journey is filled with adventures, intrigue and danger, and a prophetess tells Viggo he must find the powerful spear of Odin. What powers does the spear have? What is Loki's actual goal? And why is Viggo the key to everything that is happening?
