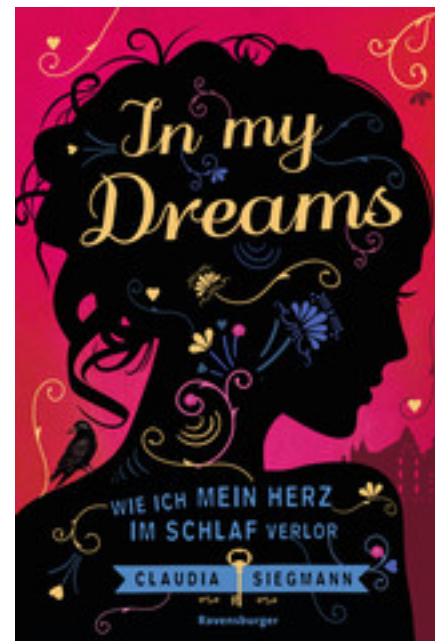

CONTENT
