### THE AUTHOR

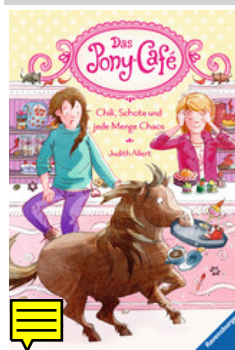
