CONTENT

When Little Rabbits Are Hurt is the fourth adventure of the Rabbit family. What on earth is going on with the Rabbits? Mama Rabbit bumps her head, Papa Rabbit hits his thumb, Hoppelbunny hurts his foot, and Hasemouse falls and scrapes a knee. First one, then two, then three Rabbits scurry from one injury to the next trying to comfort each other until finally the entire Rabbit family is gathered together. And what now? Is everyone badly hurt? Then they hear a bell ringing outside. The Rabbits go outside with their bandages and ice packs and suddenly all their injuries are forgotten: the ice cream truck is here! Happily, it wasn't so bad, after all.
