At first glance robber Grab's appearance can be quite frightening. The adventures he experiences, though, are anything but scary - they are hilarious!

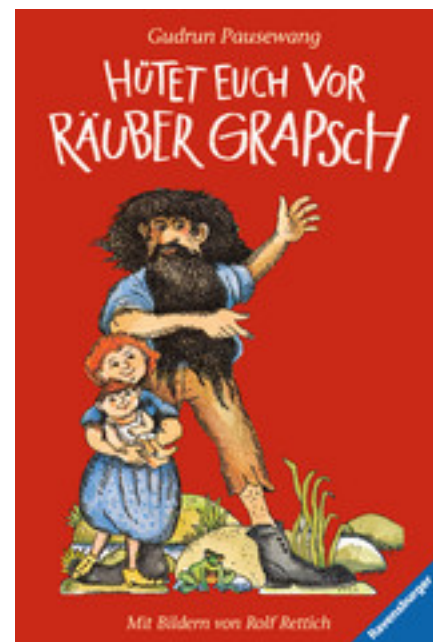
CONTENT
